We, as part of the Energy & Geoscience Institute, are involved in several of the nation's leading geoenergy research projects in the fields of Carbon Sequestration, Enhanced Geothermal Systems and Energy GeoStorage.

Successful candidates will have a strong background in at least one of the following areas: geomechanical modeling, experimental geomechanics, hydrology/reservoir engineering numerical modeling, and seismology/signal analysis.

The candidates shall also feel comfortable implementing algorithms, data acquisition and processing in MATLAB, Python and R. Knowledge of ABAQUS or COMSOL is an asset. An earned master's degree in a relevant field is preferred but not required.
